Notes and Comments

Traceback tags: The new tags now being seen on boxes at the Homerville Produce Auction are voluntary "traceback" tags.

Construction Projects:

Hitching Rail: We have replaced 100 feet of old hitching rail with 186 feet of new steel pipe hitching rail. This gives us a total of 474 feet of hitching rail (one side) for horse drawn vehicles. In addition there are places to tie 16 teams for drive-through waiting.

Concrete: We have added 1680 square feet of concrete for drive-through unloading. We have immediate plans for an additional 960 sq feet. That will give us room for 170 drive-through bins and pallets without encroaching on the loading dock or the auction floor.
