Drive-through Lot Sizes at Homerville



- We need to be flexible about lot sizes because of many different vehicle sizes.
- Tags per vehicle.
 - No more than 6-8 tags on a standard sized (7' x 16') wagon.
 - No more than 3-5 tags on a smaller wagon or hack.
 - Any more tags and the whole load should be unloaded and sold in the rows.
- No pecks or single lots are permitted in the drive-through.
 - The only exception is 15 pecks of onions.
- No more than 1 or 2 tags per wagon in the 2-9 box range.
 - The ideal situation is no small lots in the drive-through.
- Basic drive-through box lot is 10+ bushels or 15+ half bushels shrink-wrapped to a pallet.
 - Beans in bushels on one pallet can be sold as, "Take 5, 10, or all".
 - Put all sizes of pickles or tomatoes on the same pallet (or adjoining pallet) and sell as, "Choice of the sizes".
 - Everything else, sell the whole pallet as one lot.
- Your "floor lots pallet" should have been shrink-wrapped at home, and should ride through unsold in the back corner of your wagon.
 - We will forklift that "floor lots pallet(s)" for you and put it in the staging area.
 - Recover your "floor lots pallet(s)" from the staging area after you park.
 - You will have plenty of time to unpack your "floor lots pallet(s)" and row that produce on the yellow lines.
- Drive-through lots should all be palletized (use shrink-wrap) to streamline unloading.
 - This is optional but highly recommended.
 - Wagons unloading loose boxes along the dock are blocking out your buyers.
